1. Baylor Connect (RM is getting info from Baylor to have accurate info)
  - a. CONNECT is an online community to plug into student organizations and local community service opportunities. Whether they are looking to get connected on the Baylor campus or in the larger Waco community, CONNECT is the virtual pathway to student engagement. Service partners add organizational information and volunteer opportunities in order for students to find organizations they are interested in and ways to get involved. Students are able to search through categories or browse our service partners in order to be connected with volunteer opportunities that fit their passions, interests, and schedules. All Baylor students have access to CONNECT; therefore, by having a portal you have the potential to reach over 16,000 students.
