
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In Person


Proverty Solutions Initiative







CHARACTERISTICS OF A SUCCESSFUL COLLECTIVE IMPACT INITIATIVE

- Backbone organization to mobilize, facilitate, and coordinate efforts


"Collective impact is the commitment of a group of actors from different sectors to a common agenda for solving a complex social problem."



BACKBONE

"The backbone organization requires a dedicated staff separate from the participating organizations who can plan, manage, and support the initiative through ongoing facilitation, technology and communications support, data collecting and reporting, and handling the myriad logistical and administrative details for the initative to function smoothly."




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












EDUCATION

Overarching Goal: Increase community's education levels as measured by percentage of citizens with post-secondary degrees – Certificates, Associate's and Higher Degrees

- Increase % of children arriving at school ready to learn (assessed county-wide at Kindergarten entry)
- 2. Increase % of students' reading proficiency, at minimum of grade level by 3rd grade (using existing data)
- 3. Increase % of Post-secondary achievements Career Ready and/or Completed Associate's or higher degrees

FINANCIAL SECURITY

Overarching Goal: Increase the number of households in Waco with income exceeding twice the Federal Poverty Level

- 1. Increase labor force participation and employment rates for 16-24 year olds
- 2. 8th grade Cohort Completion Rate: Double economically disadvantaged students post-graduation achievement (current rate 9.5% increase 2x = 19%)

HEALTH

Overarching Goal: To improve the overall health of the community, using the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Health Rankings as the metric of measurement.

- 1. Increase the number of people with health insurance.
- 2. Improve Food Environment Index/decrease food insecurity.
- 3. Increase wellness of the community-physical activity and access to exercise opportunities.
- 4. Reduce teen pregnancy.









STRATEGIC PROGRAMMING BASED ON METRICS THAT SHAPE OUR GOALS
